DENMARK INBOUND 2007

Sat Feb 24: Arrive Christchurch

On arrival at Christchurch, and following your completion of Customs and Immigration formalities, you will be transferred to your inner city hotel, the Holiday Inn on Avon, where you will stay for the next two nights.

Your coach will follow you by road, and carry all your luggage across to Greymouth, and will be waiting at Greymouth Station when you arrive at

From Greymouth, it is a short drive south to Hokitika, where you will have ample time to look at the Greenstone (Pounamu in the Maori language) being crafted into all kinds of jewellery and souveniers.

Tonight you will stay at the Southland Hotel, located right on the West Coast.

Tue Feb 27: B.

After a hearty West Coast breakfast, you will travel south through some of the finest scenery New Zealand has to offer – make sure your cameras are at the ready.

Heading south from Hokitika, you will arrive at the small town of Whataroa, (population of about 500 !!!!) where you will be staying at the White Heron Motels for the next two nights.

When you have unpacked your cases from the coach you will be going on a Rainforest Tour for about two hours which will let you experience the real West Coast.

Tonight you can wander down the main street to the local hotel, enjoy a drink with the locals, and have a hearty West Coast Dinner.

This morning your coach will take you the short distance to Franz Josef township, Where you will be able to marvel at this alpine wonderland you find yourself in today – choices include a flight up to the Glacier, either by helicopter or fixed wing aircraft, tandem parachuting over the Glacier (for the brave at heart!!), walking to the top of the Glacier (with guides of course), a visit to the historic and beautiful church in the township, and you will have admission to the wonderful movie called *Flowing West*.

Sun Mch 04:

Today will be a day for your hosts to show you why they choose to live in Central Otago – an area that is steeped in history such as gold mining and also featured extensively in the movie "Lord of The Rings" trilogy.

Mon Mch 05:

Leaving Alexandra this morning, your coach will head north through Central Otago to Omarama, and on to Oamaru.

Omarama is known the world over as a centre of excellence in gliding circles, and many international gliding championships are held here.
